

PLAYING INFORMATION

OUTDOORS

Ladies afternoons are Tuesday and Thursday. Members sign their name in the book provided. The **BOOK CLOSES** AT 1.30 pm and the Draw takes place at 1.45 pm for 2.00 pm start.

INDOORS

Ladies Club times will be shown on the board at the beginning of the season and weekly on the rink allocation sheets. Members sign their names in the book provided. **THE DRAW WILL BE MADE 20 MINUTES BEFORE PLAY COMMENCES.**

Any rinks not being used by the ladies that are allocated to ladies session can be used for general play with the consent of the Ladies Captain

DAILY ROLL-UP (General Play)

Any member wanting to Roll-Up there is a "**sign in**" book kept on the table by the main door. Members sign in as they arrive and names are allocated to rinks on **a first come first served basis**. The players by agreement form "rinks", "triples" or "pairs" according to numbers of players and rink availability and who will play in what position (1,2,3 and Skip). This activity is an excellent stepping stone providing practice and social contact. You may invite guest bowlers who must pay the appropriate rink fee. (Envelopes are on the table by the door.)

Ladies must have been a full club member for at least two years before they can be proposed for a position on the Committee.

INDOORS

GENERAL PLAY and Early Competitions Rounds
