

Protocol for Indoor Bowling 2021/22

1 December 2021

If you or anyone in your household, are experiencing any symptoms of Covid-19 or generally feeling unwell, you must not come to the club. Any member, particularly those over 70 and those classified as vulnerable, who plays at the club does so at their own risk.

On Arrival

- A) Please sign the book
- B) Check your temperature
- C) Sanitise your hands.
- D) Members / visitors to voluntarily wear a face covering when they enter and move around club facilities.
- E) The face covering can be removed when having a drink and or meal.
- F) Where possible be considerate to others by social distancing

Before the game

- A) The face covering can be removed when on the green playing.
- B) Only club members who have paid can play.
- C) Rollup sessions are available as per the rink allocation sheet.
- D) Club, County or National competitions can book rinks. Only County or National competitions can specify a rink. Club competition rinks are drawn by the Green Ranger. Please contact **Kevin Batchelor** our Green Ranger by **WhatsApp** or text **07973 946129** or email greenranger@wpavilionbc.org advising the competition to be booked.
- E) Please collect **£5 rink fees** from each opposition player for County or National competitions, complete slip, put in envelope and post through Secretary's Office door.
- F) Session times are
Monday to Friday 8am to 9.55am; 10am to 11.55am; 12 noon – 1.55 pm, 2pm – 3.55 pm, 4pm – 5.55 pm, 6pm – 7.55pm; 8pm to close
Saturday to Sunday 8am to 9.55am; 10am to 11.55am: 12 noon to 1.55pm, 2pm – 3.55 pm, 4pm – 5.55 pm, 6pm – close

Playing bowls

- A) Do not forget hands must be sanitised or washed before and after play.
- B) Turn on the ventilation system and lights
- C) Please sanitise the jack prior to the start of the game and at the end. If you have used rink markers etc please also sanitise these.
- D) Walk up the rink on the left when changing ends
- E) Turn off ventilation system and lights, if no one else is using the rinks.

Please note

If any of members/visitors live with or have been in contact with someone who has been identified as a suspected or confirmed case of the Omicron variant they must self-isolate for 10 days, even if they have been double or triple vaccinated.

Any member who has taken a lateral or PCR test that has proven positive after visiting the club must inform Peter Woods, the Club Secretary, 01903 820079 Option 1, so that others who have been in contact can be notified.
